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instrumental in making this program a resounding success, as they worked tirelessly to facilitate the smooth functioning of the camp.

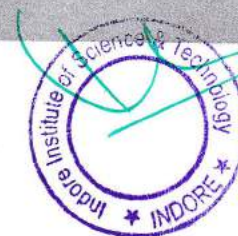
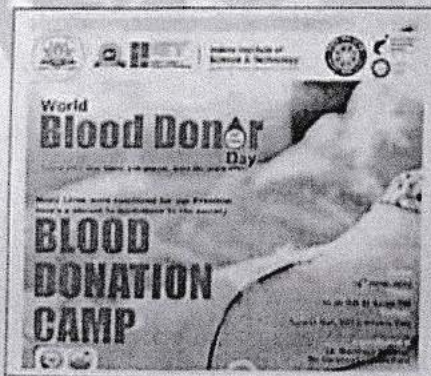

- To develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.

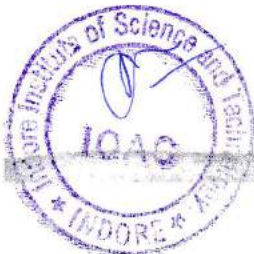

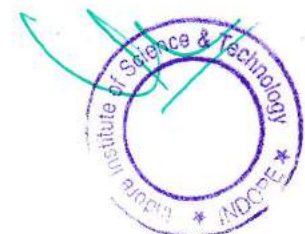

Day 1: 22/03/2023, Wednesday

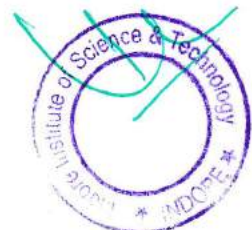

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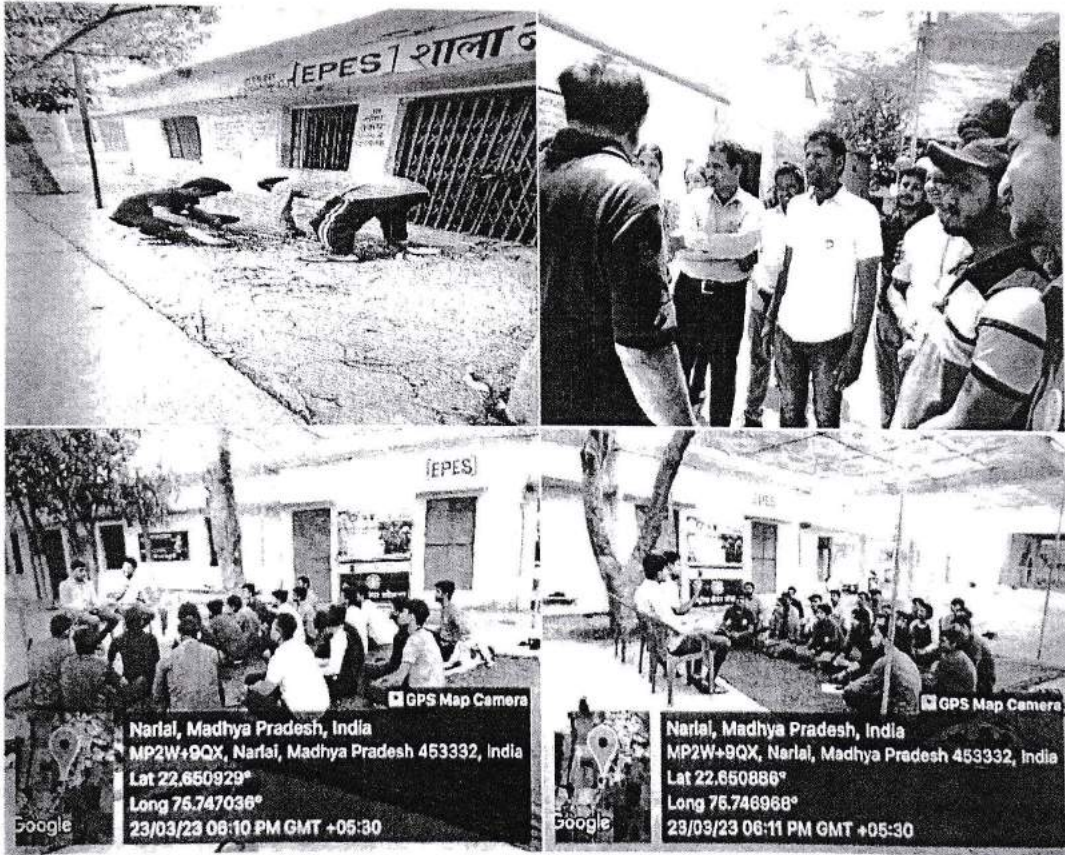


Day 2: 23/03/2023, Thursday

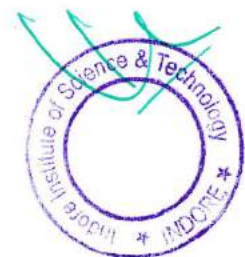

Community Service

These lines become sentiments when a person is a part of NSS. The NSS volunteers participated in various community services during the camp held in Narlai from 22 March 2023 to 28 March 2023.

The objective of this camp was to develop an interface between the two different folklores, strengthen the bond of compatibility and to downturn the gaps in the society. It also aimed to develop long term institutional relation with the community and contribution to the enhancement of people there as well as create awareness among teacher trainees regarding their responsibilities towards the society. These goals were accomplished when the adept volunteers of NSS undertook the responsibility of the village and its surroundings.

Ranging from digging compost pit to interacting with villagers they did everything in their reach to provide their best to society. The plastic waste was properly collected and disposed of too.

Another important activity that was performed by the volunteers was cleaning of the premises. The school campus right from the playground area to the classrooms were all cleaned and sanitized completely. The volunteers performed 'Shramdaan' i.e. they cleaned the premises by removing the dirt and the plastic waste and then levelled it by removing stones to make it better for the students over there. The cleaning of kitchen was given extra importance in order to ensure good health of the students. The volunteers not only focused on cleaning but also beautifying the premises by planting saplings with medical usage such as Amla and Sheesham. Just planting trees won't help the environment, so the volunteers took great care of the plants and also asked the students to take care of them after the camp.

Students met the Sarpanch of the village; interacted with him on various topics like facility they are providing to villagers especially how they benefit women.





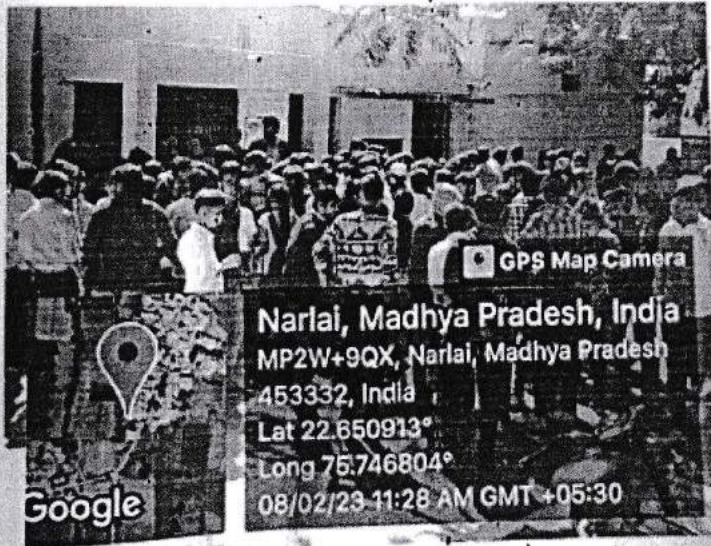
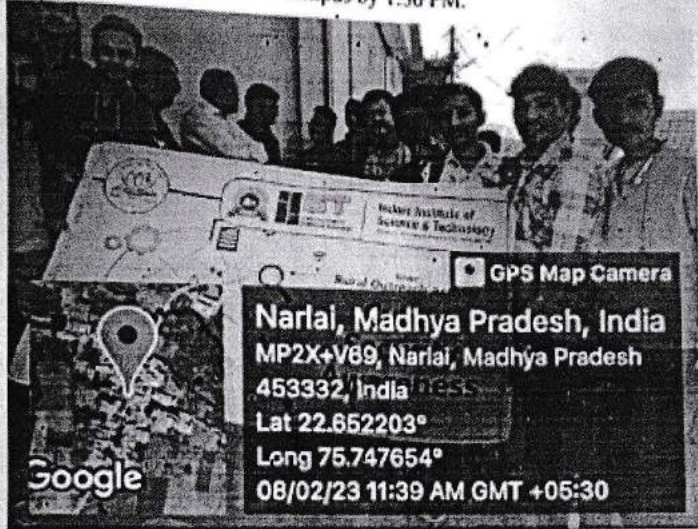
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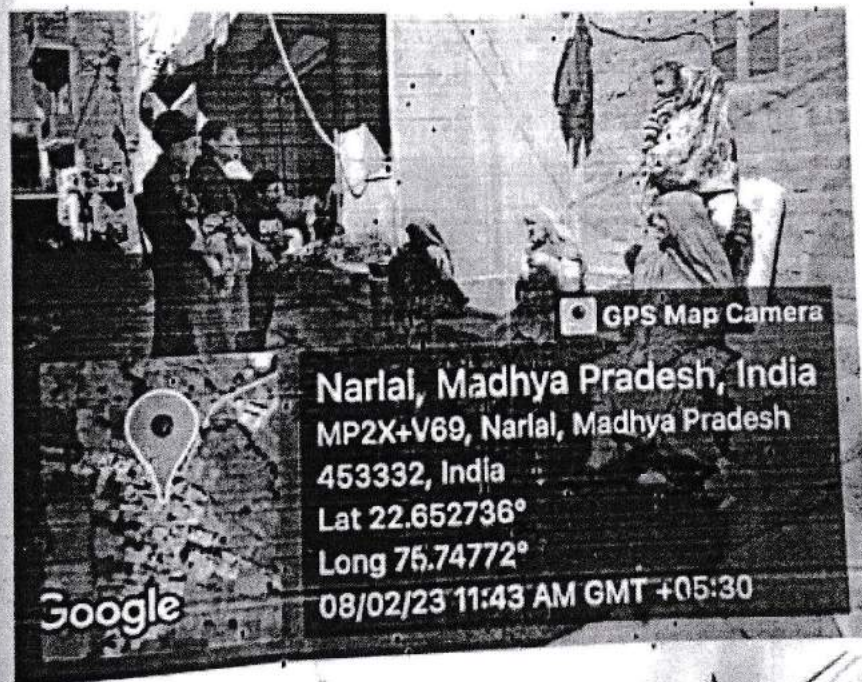
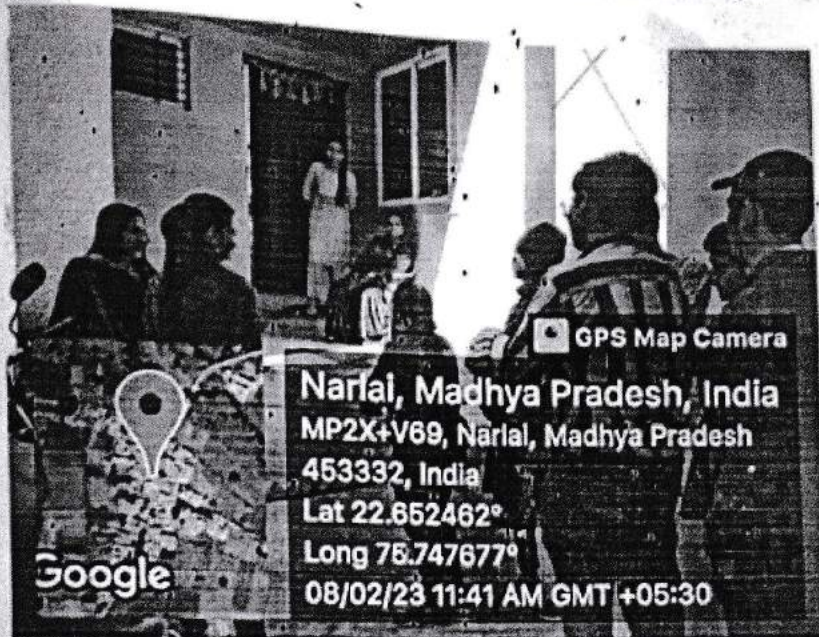

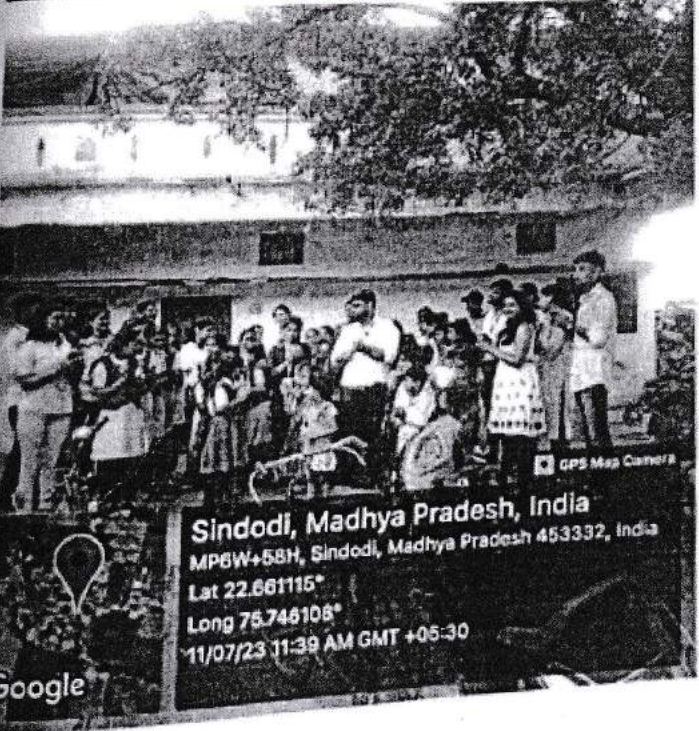
