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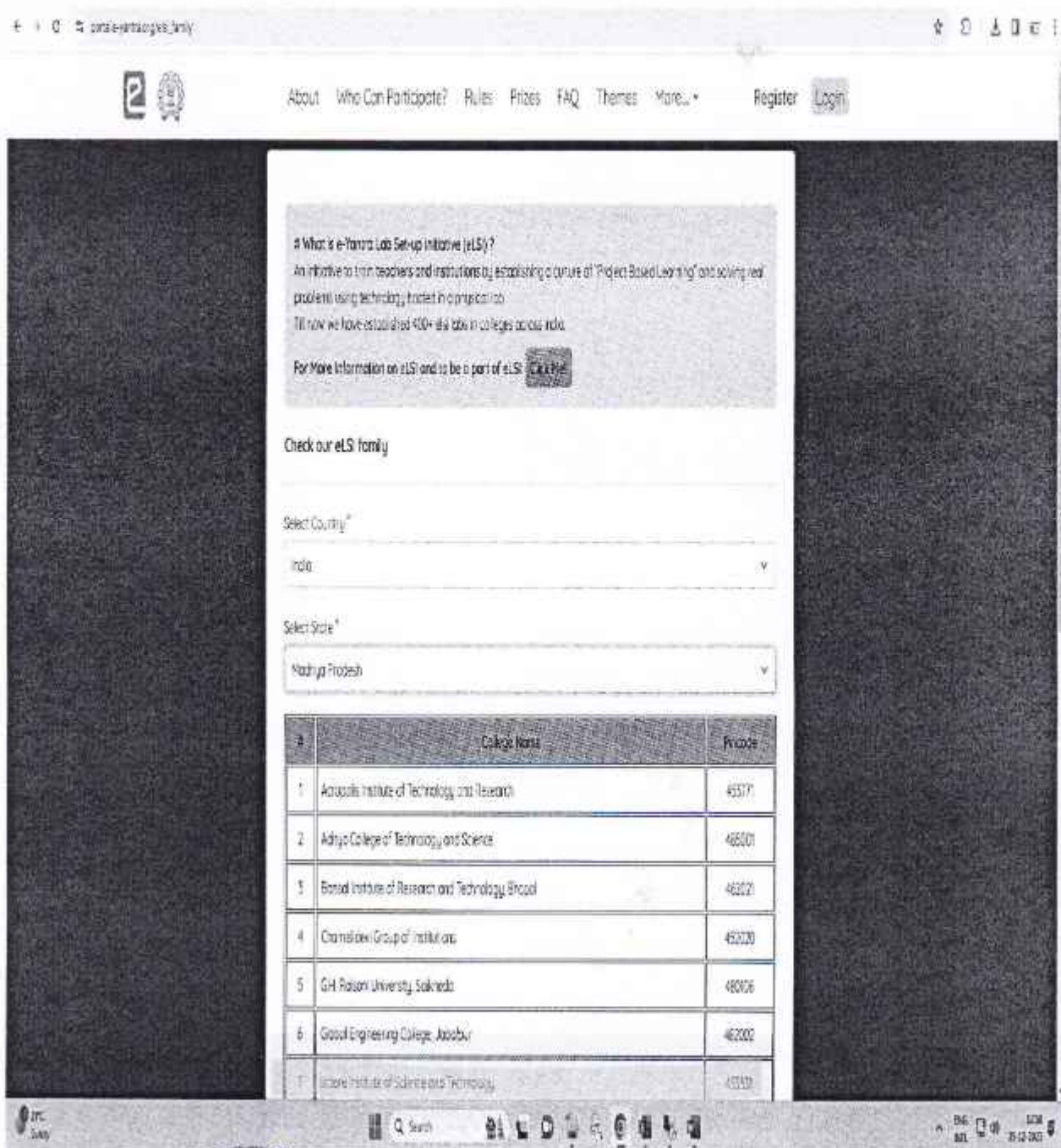

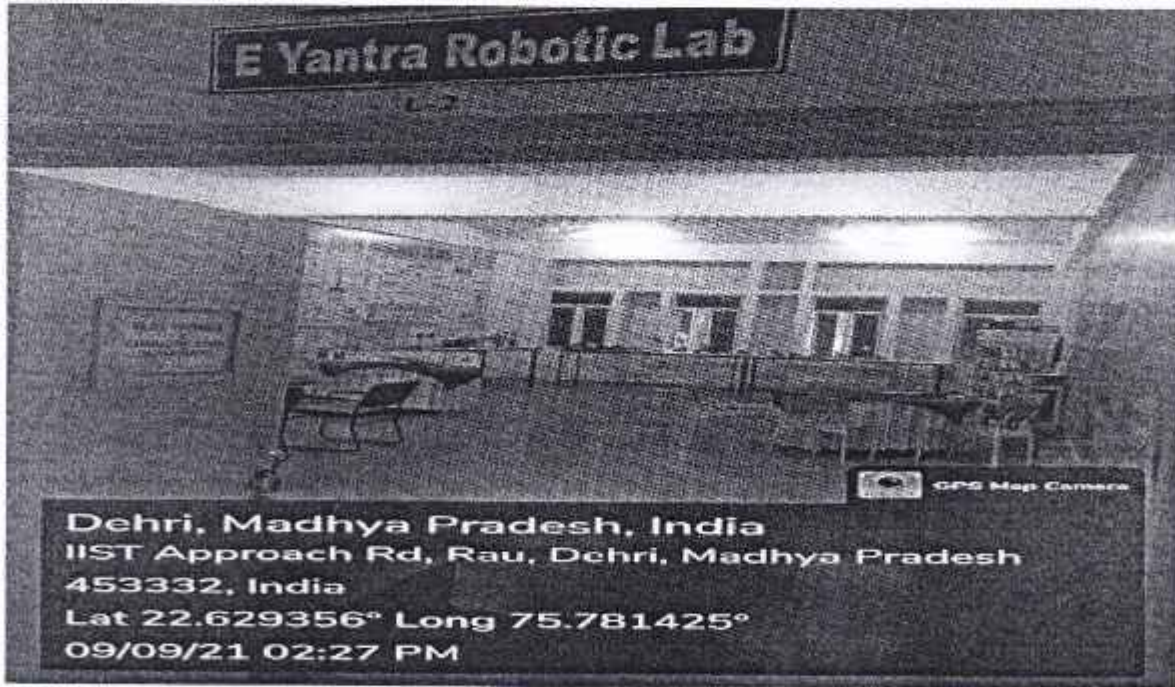

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
ALL INDIA COUNCIL FOR TECHNICAL EDUCATION (AICTE)
AND
National Program Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL)**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) executed on this 3rd day of July, 2018 by and between:

All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), through its Advisor-I (RIFD), has its office at 3rd Floor, Nelson Mandela Marg, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi - 110070, a *Statutory Body* under the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India established under the All India Council for Technical Education Act, 1987 (hereinafter referred to as the "AICTE") on the **first part**.

AND

National Program Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) through its Coordinator, NPTEL, CCE, IIT Madras, Chennai has its office at IIT Madras, on the **second part**.

WHEREAS, AICTE and NPTEL are desirous to execute AICTE-NPTEL Faculty Development Programmes for teachers in AICTE's approved technical institutions through NPTEL MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses) Advanced Courses and these NPTEL courses undertaken and successfully completed by faculty shall now be considered for faculty promotions under CAS/direct recruitment.

AND WHEREAS, both AICTE and NPTEL are mutually desirous to set forth in this MoU certain terms and conditions applicable to both for executing the scheme.

1. **Purpose of Agreement**

This Agreement is entered between AICTE and NPTEL for defining terms & conditions of the NPTEL Advanced level courses, good enough to be Faculty Development Programmes, through MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses) and role & responsibilities of both the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, both parties agree to the following terms and conditions: -

- i. NPTEL is already conducting Advance and Basic Level courses through MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses)
- ii. A large number of Advance Level Courses are being offered by NPTEL. These are 1 credit, 2 credit and 3 credit courses.
- iii. Since MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses) of NPTEL are not full time like regular FDPs, it is decided that its equivalence to regular FDP shall be considered as under.

- iv. NPTEL MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses) will have regular assignments and in person examination at the end. A test will be conducted by NPTEL and a certificate be issued to only those participants who attended the programme and qualify in the test.

2. Role & responsibilities of NPTEL

- (i) It shall be the responsibility of NPTEL to conduct advance level courses through MOOCs, which are good enough to be FDP.
- (ii) NPTEL will do the certification of these courses with AICTE.
- (iii) NPTEL will act as facilitator for the operation of the programmes.
- (iv) NPTEL through its Academic Affairs Council (this is the senates of the different IITs that run courses on NPTEL) and its Programme Implementation Committee (Chaired by Director, IIT Madras and all NPTEL coordinators are member) will identify the set of advanced courses that are good enough to be FDP.
- (v) The list of courses will be advertised on the NPTEL portal (npTEL.ac.in) and a record of courses approved every semester will be maintained on the same portal.
- (vi) Online portal will be modified by NPTEL to invite applications for the conduct of advance level courses through MOOCs and the link also be provided at AICTE website.
- (vii) Since the NPTEL courses are supported by MHRD, NPTEL will be accountable for finance/grants sanctioned under the scheme and shall abide by terms and conditions stipulated by MHRD for financial grants.
- (viii) NPTEL will constitute a Steering Committee for effecting implementation of scheme. AICTE will provide its representative as a member on that Committee.
- (ix) After conduct of each programme, NPTEL will provide to AICTE a list of participant faculty from engineering college, along with their contact details, who attended the MOOCs programme in the eligible NPTEL courses and successfully completed the same.
- (x) A special joint certificate will be issued by NPTEL to the participants who attended the MOOCs programme in the eligible NPTEL courses and successfully completed the same. The specially designed joint certificate will carry AICTE logo and signatures of Advisor, AICTE and NPTEL Coordinator appended on it.
- (xi) NPTEL will ensure that the above said certificate shall be issued only to those participants who qualify examinations.

3. Role & responsibilities of AICTE: -

- (i) AICTE shall nominate a representative to attend the meetings of Steering Committee for monitoring the implementation of the terms and conditions laid down in the MoU.
- (ii) An appropriate advertisement shall be placed by AICTE and NPTEL and applications will be invited online on NPTEL web portal with the link on AICTE website.
- (iii) AICTE shall conduct surprise visit to some centres while the conduct of test is in progress. NPTEL will provide the schedule to AICTE in advance.

4. Validity of Agreement

This arrangement shall be effective up to maximum of five years, starting from the date of signing of the Agreement and its continuance will be subject to annual review of the scheme and deliverables. The continuance of the scheme is also subject to the AICTE policy, its rules, regulations, by-laws and guidelines formulated for this purpose from time to time.

5. Amendments & Modifications

Any revision/modification or change to this agreement may be made by either party only by mutual consent and unless such revision/modification or change is acknowledged and accepted by both parties in writing, such revision/modification or change shall not be valid and binding on the parties to this agreement.

6. Dispute-Resolution & Jurisdiction

Any dispute arising out of the work assigned to the NPTEL under the scheme, which cannot be amicably settled between the parties viz., AICTE (on one part) and NPTEL (on the other) shall be referred to the Arbitration Tribunal consisting of three arbitrators, one arbitrator shall be nominated by the first party and one arbitrator shall be nominated by the second party and the third arbitrator to be mutually decided by both the arbitrators under the provisions of Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The seat of the Tribunal will be at New Delhi and the proceedings shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996..

This Agreement/MoU shall be enforceable within the jurisdiction of Delhi Courts only.



7. Termination


The AICTE, in its sole discretion by giving prior notice of one month to the other party, may terminate this agreement without assigning any reason. In addition to above, AICTE may also terminate this agreement instantly and without giving notice to the other party, in case of a change of policy pertaining to the implementation of the scheme or in the event of any breach of this agreement by the other party or any irregularity or dissatisfaction noted in the implementation of the scheme.

This MoU/agreement shall come into force from the date both the parties have signed the same.

Both the parties have considered and read the T&C of this agreement and thereafter agreed to sign this MoU on 3rd July 2018.

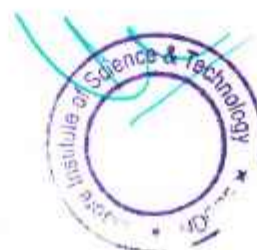

NPTEL is conducting Advance and Basic Level courses through MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses). A large number of Advance Level Courses with 1 credit, 2 credit and 3 credit are being offered by NPTEL. Since MOOCs of NPTEL are not full time like regular FDPs, AICTE has also made its equivalence to regular FDP which shall be considered as under.

- A 4-week of NPTEL online Course is equivalent to half-week FDP.
- An 8-week of NPTEL online Course is equivalent to one-week FDP.
- A 12-week of NPTEL online Course is equivalent to one and a half-week FDP.

 - "Curriculum" means the Courses, Course Materials, Manuals, and any and all instructional content, assessments, tests, and instructional materials included therein whether in print or electronic format, provided by Red Hat as part of the Red Hat Academy Program.
 - "Course" or "Courses" means the specific courses or units of study that may be taught under the RNA and as set forth in Exhibit A, Exhibit C and as otherwise offered by Red Hat under the Red Hat Academy Program.

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHEREAS:

A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

- G) Give related information, its branches, and dimensional information about the industry concerned with whom the MoU is sworn.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

**CLAUSE 1
CO-OPERATION**



THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter called 'MOU') dated
1 October 2021 is made on the Academic Exchange between:

Curtin University Malaysia incorporated as a University pursuant to the Universities and University Colleges Act of 1971, located at Lot 2160, Kuala Baram Land District, Lutong, CDT 250, 98009 Miri, owned and managed by Curtin (Malaysia) Sendirian Berhad (Company No. 464213-M), a company incorporated and registered under the Companies Act, 1965 in Malaysia with its registered address at Lot 986, 1st Floor, Jalan Bendahara, 98000 Miri, Sarawak Miri, Sarawak, Malaysia (hereinafter referred to as 'CURTIN' or 'Party' or 'University', collectively referred to herein as the 'Parties' or 'Universities'); and

Indore Institute of Science and Technology is a premier institution in the central India established in 2003 located at Rau - Pithampur Rd, Opposite Indian Institute of Management, Rau, Indore, Madhya Pradesh 453331 (hereinafter referred to as 'IIST Indore' or 'Party', collectively referred to herein as the 'Parties').

WHEREAS:

1. The Parties recognize the value of international cooperation and have agreed to continue their common interest in promoting the mutual cooperation in the area of education and research;

THUS:



2. The Parties agree to implement the MOU under the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, and
3. The Parties agree that while the educational cooperation proposed in this document is concentrating on the institutional level, in the future it may be extended to other content of specific disciplines by mutual agreement.

The terms and conditions of the MOU are as follows:

General Provisions:

1. Both parties will make every reasonable effort to encourage educational and research cooperation to the extent that they are able under the provisions of this agreement and endeavor to cooperate in areas of mutual interest. Within domains that are mutually agreed to, both institutions agree on the following general forms of cooperation:
 - 1.1. Joint education and research activities
 - 1.2. Exchange of faculty members for research, and discussion
 - 1.3. Exchange of students for study and research
 - 1.4. Exchange of academic materials and academic publications
 - 1.5. Organization of joint academic and scientific conferences

Principles:

1. The aim of both institutions is to develop and offer higher education of the highest quality that effectively addresses human resources needs in society, by applying innovative student-centered outcome-based learning methodologies. Parties intend to share knowledge, experiences and educational research results and to support each other in further educational development.
2. Both the parties intend to collaborate in research activities following the research ethics policy and procedure of both the universities.
3. Visits by academic staff members will be encouraged for the mutual benefit of both parties. Suitable arrangements will be made for the exchange of visiting scholars for collaboration in teaching and in research.
4. A student programme may include student exchanges, joint supervision of postgraduate students, and the provision of library access and academic assistance for doctoral research.



students. Such activities shall be negotiated and agreed to by the parties on a case-by-case basis.

5. The two parties will seek opportunities to cooperate in research. The details of specific proposals will be determined by the mutual agreement of relevant faculties of both parties. The form of cooperation may vary with the goal of each project.
6. To facilitate academic and cultural interchange, the exchange of research materials, publications and information will be encouraged. Each university will invite the other, when appropriate, to participate in conferences, symposia and short visits. Joint educational programs and joint curriculum development are encouraged as well.
7. Any proposals for any form of cooperative work under this MOU between the Parties shall be detailed under separate agreements to be signed by both Parties.
8. Any expenses or operational budget arising as a result of this MOU shall be addressed on case-by-case basis under a separate agreement and shall be based on the responsibilities of each Parties involved in the cooperative work.
9. The protection of intellectual property rights shall be enforced in conformity with the IP policy and procedures of both the universities, and the respective national laws, rules and regulations of the Parties and with other international agreements signed by both parties.
10. Notwithstanding anything in paragraph No. 8 above, the intellectual property rights in respect of any technological development, and any products and services development, carried out
 - (i) jointly by the Parties or research results obtained through the joint activity effort of the Parties, shall be jointly owned by the Parties in accordance with the terms to be mutually agreed upon; and
 - (ii) solely and separately by the Party or the research results obtained through the sole and separate effort of the Party shall be solely owned by the party concerned
11. The use of name, logo and/or official emblem of any of the Parties on any publication, document and/or paper is prohibited without the prior written approval of either Party.



12. Each Party shall undertake to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from or supplied to, the other Party during the period of the implementation of this MOU or any other agreements made pursuant to this MOU.
13. For purpose of paragraph No. 11 above, such documents, information and data include any documents, information and data which is disclosed by a Party (the Disclosing Party) to the other Party (the Receiving Party) prior to, or after, the execution of this MOU, involving technical, business, marketing, policy, know-how, planning, project management and other documents, information data and/or solutions in any form, including but not limited to any document, information or data which designated in writing to be confidential or by its nature intended to be for the knowledge of the Receiving Party or if orally given, is given in the circumstances of confidence.
14. Both Parties agree that the provisions of these paragraphs No. 11 and 12 shall continue to be binding between the Parties notwithstanding the termination of this MOU.
15. This MOU shall remain in force for a period of 3 years from the date of the last signature. The MOU may be extended by mutual consent of both parties; and may be terminated by either party by written notice at least six months in advance. Termination of the MOU will not affect participants from completing their activities at the host institution.
16. Any amendments to this MOU can only be made in writing and after consultation and mutual consent of the two parties. Such amendments, once approved by both institutions, will become part of this MOU and are incorporated by reference.
17. Any differences of opinion and interpretations of this MOU shall be settled by mutual consultation or negotiation between CURTIN and IIST Indore.
18. Every university participated in this agreement should mention the other partner university website (hyperlink) on their own official website.
19. Each party will assign a key contact person to be responsible for the execution of this memorandum of understanding.

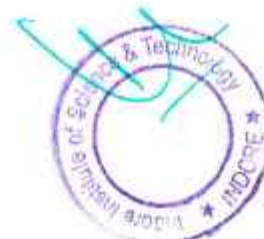





As the context may require, HET and IIST INDORE are collectively referred to as the 'Parties' and individually referred to as 'Party' in this MOU.

WHEREAS:

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS UNDER:

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

This MOU has been executed for the purpose of organizing workshops/ seminars/ training sessions at the premises of IIST INDORE or such other premises as may be mutually agreed upon and shall remain in force for a period of **THREE YEAR**, commencing from the date of execution. This MOU shall terminate after completion of the term of three year, without any financial obligations of Parties, except for pending reimbursements and costs as provided herein. Both the Parties may execute similar agreements for similar initiatives in future or even extend the term of this MOU for such further periods. Either party can voluntarily terminate this MOU by giving 3 months' notice in writing to the other.

It is agreed that IIST INDORE shall not copy or infringe upon the initiatives or programmes of HET in terms of its program offerings, videos, materials in any of their other individual initiatives and all copyrights shall vest with HET.

ASSIGNMENT

This MOU is personal to the Parties and the rights and obligations established herein shall not be assignable by the Parties, except to the extent expressly permitted under this MOU or with the prior written consent of the other party.

INDEMNITY

Except for cost reimbursements, the Services offered by HET are on a mutual basis and free of cost. Only willing participants for their own wellbeing / self-development are required to participate. IIST INDORE may for development of its students make the HET Programmes/Modules as part of its curriculum. The Parties therefore, agree that such services do not give rise to any kind of damage or liability to anybody who participates and therefore no damage can arise therefrom. No indemnity is therefore provided herein. It is clearly understood that HET programs do not guarantee success of its objectives or initiatives mentioned in the Article above.

GOVERNING LAW, JURISDICTION & ARBITRATION

This MOU shall be construed, interpreted and enforced in accordance with Laws of India. In case of any differences, both the parties, shall make all efforts to settle the disputes amicably through mutual discussion and negotiation, failing which, dispute(s) shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator appointed by both the Parties, as per provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. Language of Arbitration shall be English and place of Arbitration shall be Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh. Subject to the Arbitration Clause, the Courts of competent jurisdiction at Vijayawada shall have exclusive jurisdiction in respect of any and all matters pertaining to this MOU.





MISCELLANEOUS

- i) This MOU can only be amended in writing by mutual consent of both the Parties. No modification or amendment to this MOU and no waiver of any of the terms or conditions hereof shall be valid or binding unless made in writing and duly executed by or on behalf of both the Parties.
- ii) This MOU may be executed in counterparts including but not limited to MOUs, communications exchanged defining responsibilities, obligations of both the Parties for different programs, initiatives etc. under this MOU, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, and all of which, taken together, shall constitute an integral part of this MOU.
- iii) If any provision of this MOU shall be invalid, illegal or otherwise unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall in no way be affected or impaired thereby.
- iv) The captions of the clauses of this MOU are for convenience of reference only and in no way define, limit or affect the scope or substance of any clause of this MOU.
- v) The arrangement contemplated herein being in nature of cooperative strategic alliance for general wellbeing, no monetary consideration is involved.
- vi) None of the provisions of this agreement as stated above shall be deemed to constitute a partnership between HET and IST INDORE and no party shall have any authority to bind or shall be deemed to be the agent of the other in any way, it is on principle to principle basis;
- vii) Neither party shall exercise any rights in the trademarks, copyright or other intellectual property of the other party, except as expressly stipulated herein.
- viii) All intellectual property rights (IPR) in "Heartfulness", The "Heartfulness" technique of Relaxation/ its connected procedures, "Heartfulness" Relaxation, Heartfulness Cleaning and other Trademarks of HET or of those of its associates used by HET under license shall always vest with HET or its associates and it reserves the right to use the same internally or externally at its sole discretion. IST INDORE shall not have any rights over the program content/module usage which may be exploited by IST INDORE only with the prior written permission of HET and in coordination and assistance of HET authorized representatives who are experts in this area. If the version of "Heartfulness" Relaxation/ its connected procedures, "Heartfulness Meditation" is modified or improved, HET may implement such changed versions of wellness techniques anytime during the term of this MOU.

SCHEDULE- 1
Scope of Work

Heartfulness Education Trust (HET) shall offer the following programs specifically developed for specific needs of the University:

1. **Staff Training:** HET shall impart a training program on "Wellness at work" to all Principals, Teachers and Staff of the IIST INDORE institutions at its campus. IIST INDORE may at its sole discretion make it compulsory for their faculty/staff. Initially, this would be a three-day program to introduce the Heartfulness Meditation Practice and how it can be integrated into best education practices. This wellness program can also be offered at Kanha Shanti Vanam, the world headquarters of Heartfulness located near chegur village, RangaReddy district with a residential programme facility on mutually agreed basis.
2. **In-depth Faculty Training on Heartfulness Curricula:** Following initial introduction, interested faculty would be provided a longer duration in-depth teacher training program to further enhance and develop the Heartfulness tools and Curricula. This program would be developed suitably by Heartfulness Education Trust and made available at Kanha Shanti Vanam / Heartfulness centers or on IIST INDORE campus on an ongoing basis on agreed intervals during the term of this MOU.
3. **HELM (Heartfulness Enabled Leadership Mastery) curriculum for students :** HET shall choose a college on IIST INDORE campus to begin an in-depth training for students. This would cover a 3 day induction program and a 16-week life-skills course which will be followed by subsequent foundational leadership programs such as Discover, Develop etc which can be included as credit courses. These are core Heartfulness programs conducted by certified Heartfulness trainers which will be experiential sessions of 60-90 minutes for each student group.

Memorandum of Understanding between IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation and Indore Institute of Science and Technology, Indore

This MoU is made at [place] on the 24th day of March 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the "MoU").

BETWEEN

IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation located at IIT Indore campus, Khandwa Road, Simrol, Indore, Madhya Pradesh, India and incorporated as a section 8, not for profit, company under the Companies Act, 2013 (hereinafter referred to as "**IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation**") which expression, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, includes its successors and assigns, of the First Party.

AND

Indore Institute of Science & Technology (IIST), located at the address Opposite IIM, Pithampur Road, Rau, Indore, Madhya Pradesh (hereinafter referred to as "**IIST**") which expression shall, unless it is repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns of the Second Party.

First Party and Second Party are hereinafter together referred to as "**Parties**" and individually as "**Party**".

1. PREAMBLE

WHEREAS "**IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation**" supports (a) Technology Development and commercialization through financial grants in the form of fellowships with development grant and mentorship to students and faculties of Indian academic institutions; (b) Conducts skill development programs for students and upskilling programs for Faculties; and (c) Promotes technology-based startups through grants, equity-based investments, and mentoring.

WHEREAS, "**Second Party**" is an Indian academic institution affiliated with RGPV, Bhopal University and is involved in dissemination of knowledge to its students through curriculum and extracurricular activities, support for job placement to students, support to current and alumni students in their entrepreneurial journey.

WHEREAS, "**Second Party**" is willing to be part of journey to promote Commercializable Technology Development, Skill Development and Startup Ecosystem at its institution by partnering with "**IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation**" and by leveraging its extensive experience and resources for the same purpose;

A. The Parties hereto share a common interest in PROMOTING research development, skilling of human resources and supporting startups working in the upcoming area of Cyber-Physical Systems.

B. In order to promote future institutional cooperation, the Parties hereto wish to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU").

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2. SCOPE OF MoU

NOW THEREFORE, as duly communicated and agreed by and between the parties the conditions of this MoU are as follows:

IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation Responsibilities (please refer to Annexure A)

- A. For Technology Development - IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation will provide financial and technical support to the students and faculties for the productization of deep technology based CPS solutions developed in Lab and go-to-market support to CPS based research outcomes as per the mandate. The students and faculties will apply to specific links provided for the same. Review will be conducted based on the mandate of IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation.
- B. IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation will conduct skill development sessions for students and faculties in technologies like Cloud Computing, Industrial Automation, Internet of Things (IoT), Programming Languages, and Simulation Software among other required technologies.
- C. Alumni and faculties willing to pursue their idea and develop it into a Startup may be supported through Entrepreneur-in-residence (EIR), PRAYAS, Internship and Seed Support programs at IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation as per program mandate. These programs offer financial assistance, physical incubation at IIT Indore, and technical and business mentorship to the entrepreneurs.
- D. Detailed current support from IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation has been provided in Annexure A. The support shall change from time to time based on available resources at disposal of the foundation.

Second Party Responsibilities

- A. The institute will share the updated CV/Resume of third and final year students who have been trained/skilled/supported through programs with IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation for placement and internship opportunities with the partner industries and startups.
- B. Supporting IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation in promoting their programs to current students and alumni of the college.
- C. Cooperation in the development of industry connects and skilling programs, including the potential for offering joint programs, especially in the domain of Cyber-Physical Systems as well as joint efforts for commercialization of Lab Projects and Products.
- D. Pursuit of joint consulting and project opportunities in future.
- E. Provide access to available labs and testing facilities to the associated startups at nominal cost/Free of Cost.





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F. Provide details of students' placement those who have gone through skill development program.

"Indore Institute of Science & Technology (IIST)" will be designated as Satellite skilling and support center for beneficiaries of IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation. In this case, the name of "Indore Institute of Science & Technology (IIST)" will be mentioned at the website of IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation as partner institution in that region for skilling.

IITI DRISHTI CPS Foundation and "Indore Institute of Science & Technology (IIST)" will jointly run Skilling programs for recipients of "Indore Institute of Science & Technology (IIST)" as well as external recipients based on strengths and infrastructure available at "Indore Institute of Science & Technology (IIST)". Costs involved for the same and revenue generated shall be shared by both the institutions on a case-to-case basis, decided at the time of floating the course/program.

3. NOT LEGALLY BINDING

This MOU is not intended to be and is not to be construed as a legally binding agreement. Signing of this MOU does not result in any material, financial or other obligation for either of the parties hereto. By signing this MOU, the parties are signifying their desire for future collaboration. Specific initiatives may be considered and agreed upon, on a case-by-case basis, including the contributions and obligations of each institution. Subsidiary agreements may be signed as required.

4. NO EXCLUSIVITY CLAUSE

While this MoU in no way restricts either party from participating with other agencies, organizations and individuals on similar arrangements or other memorandum of understanding, the Parties agree and acknowledge that such other MoU shall not conflict and/or impinge upon a Party's ability to effectively fulfil its responsibilities under this MoU.

5. TENURE OF MoU

This MoU is valid, subject to fulfillment of the conditions as mentioned herein for a period of twenty-four (24) months from the date of its coming into effect or any other date ("Effective Date"). However, this can be extended with mutual written agreement by both parties. Both parties agree to bear their own expenses relating to deliverables under this agreement.

6. CONFIDENTIALITY AND IP

6.1 For the purposes of this Agreement, the term "Confidential Information" shall mean all non-public written, electronic, oral, visual or intangible information disclosed to either party by the other party. Each Party will maintain the confidentiality of any information it receives from the other Party which is marked confidential or proprietary or which would, under the circumstances, appear to a reasonable person to be confidential or proprietary.





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- 6.2 The confidentiality does not apply to information:
- that is in the public domain through no fault of a Party,
 - is required to be disclosed by law,
 - is disclosed with the consent of the disclosing Party,
 - is independently developed by the receiving Party without use of any Confidential Information of the disclosing Party or
 - was previously in the receiving Party's possession, as shown by its pre-existing records, without violation of any responsibility of confidentiality
- 6.3 All intellectual property rights existing prior to the Effective date of this MoU shall belong to the party that owned such rights immediately prior to the Effective date. Neither party shall gain by virtue of this MoU any rights of ownership of copyrights, patents, trade secrets, trademarks or any other intellectual property rights owned by the other.
- 6.4 If the parties decide to undertake and joint development pursuant to this MoU, any such joint development shall be governed by a separate joint development MoU to be negotiated in good faith by the parties and executed prior to the commencement of any joint development efforts.
- 6.5 Neither party, without the express prior consent of the other party, shall use trademarks, service marks, proprietary words or symbols of the other party.
- 6.6 Except for claims of intellectual property infringement or breach of confidentiality obligations, in no event shall either Party be liable to the other Party for any lost profits or savings, lost business, loss of data, loss of revenue, loss of use or money, loss of business, loss of opportunity or any incidental, special, indirect, or consequential damages (whether or not also constituting one of the foregoing specific types of loss), whether based on breach of contract, tort (including without limitation negligence), or otherwise and whether or not such Party has been advised of the possibility of such damage.
- 6.7 Notwithstanding anything contained in this MoU, the Promoting Organization shall adhere to the provisions of the Information Technology Act, 2000 (Act), and/or such other applicable laws with respect to data security, breach of privacy and confidentiality.

7. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither Party shall be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective responsibilities under this MoU due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to acts of god, war, flood, earthquakes, strikes not confined to the premises of the party, lockouts beyond the control of the Party claiming force majeure, epidemics, riots, civil commotions etc. provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such even the Party affected thereby shall give a notice in writing to the other within thirty (30) days of such occurrence or cessation. If the force majeure conditions continue beyond three (3) months, the Parties shall jointly decide about the future course of action.





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8. TERMINATION OF ENGAGEMENT AND EXIT POLICY

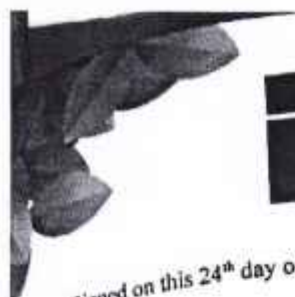
Both parties can terminate this agreement at any point by giving one (1) month advance notice in writing of their termination to the other party from the date of coming into effect of this agreement.

9. APPLICABLE LAW, JURISDICTION AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- 9.1 This Agreement and the rights and responsibilities of the Parties under or arising out of this Agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of India.
- 9.2 The parties shall endeavor to resolve any dispute relating to the rights, duties, terms and conditions contained in this agreement amicably through conciliation by engaging in discussions and mutual negotiations in good faith.
- 9.3 However if the dispute remains unresolved through conciliation within a period of 30 (thirty) days after commencement of discussions, the same shall be decided by way of arbitration, the arbitration of such disputes would be handled by the Committee. The verdict of the Committee would be final and binding.
- 9.4 Courts at Indore, Madhya Pradesh alone shall have jurisdiction on all matters arising out of, concerning to or touching upon this Agreement.
