In the AY 17-18 female students accounted for 13.33% of total enrolments and males accounted for 86.67%, resulting in a gender imbalance of 73.34%. The higher enrolment of male students can be due to a few reasons. An analysis of the last five years is presented here.

Total Enrolments Students







- GPS-enabled buses: All buses transporting girls have GPS tracking for added security.








