### SUMMARY :-

The Lexicon Club, IIST organized the event of "THE MODEL PARLIAMENT 2.0 - Winter Session" for the institute on March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and brought together students to discuss the critical topic of "Should Developed and Developing countries be equally responsible for reducing carbon emissions?". The participants of this event were selected through a screening process which was conducted online by the party leaders in 2 phases - 24<sup>th</sup> February to 28<sup>th</sup> February and 3<sup>rd</sup> March to 7<sup>th</sup> March. Applications for the online screening were sent out through a Google Form from 20<sup>th</sup> February. There were 188 applications and 50+ students gave the screening out of which 36 were selected for the main event along with the core team members of the Lexicon club. The screening took place through a debate and a discussion on the topics "Alienation and Prejudices: Are all states treated fairly?" And "Budget 2023: Saviour or Killer of the Indian Economy" which were selected by the students as per their strength and interest. The event started with the National Anthem in the presence of DGO Sir and Principal Sir and all the departmental HODs. Both the sessions also had the presence of the faculty coordinator of the event Mrs. Rupali Tiwari. There were 3 parties involved in these sessions. The Unified Opinion Front which was the leftist party lead by Mr. Nav Raj Rana, The Social Democratic Party which was the centrist party lead by Mr. Adityavandhan Jain and The National Republican Front which was led by Ms. Khushi Bhoj. The event was divided into 2 sessions, both of which took place in the Seminar Hall III, the first session whose Hon'ble. Speaker was Ms. Sabahat Ahmad comprised of an opening statement from the speakers of all 3 parties followed by an active multi-faceted discussion inclusive of facts and modal politics. Second session, whose Hon'ble. Speaker was Mr. Yuvraj Singh Narolia similarly had a debate and discussion session which was much more solution oriented in nature. After the declaration of the winning bill, it was presided by the leader of Right Party to the Parliament. The media team then led by Mr. Yuvraj Kashikawa asked questions to the parties. Both the sessions ended with a concluding speech by DGO Sir on the topic.
